NOTIFICATION

BOMBAY MOTOR VEHICLES TAX ACT, 1958.

No. PSP.2000/CR-106(II)/Road-8.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1-A), (1-B), (1-C), (1-D) and (1-E) of section 20 of the Bombay Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1958 (Bom. LXV of 1958), and of all the powers enabling it in this behalf, and in supersession of Government Notification, Public Works Department No. PSP. 2000/CR-106(I)/Roads-8, dated the 28th March 2002, the Government of Maharashtra hereby declares that toll shall be levied on the classes of motor vehicles specified in column (2) of the Schedules A, B, C, D and E appended hereto, and on the trailers drawn by such vehicles, passing over the Mumbai-Pune Expressway in Panvel and Khalapur Talukas in Raigad District and Maval and Haveli Talukas in Pune District and also the bypasses flyovers, bridges and tunnels constructed on the said section of road and approach roads and connectors thereto, at the rates and for the periods specified against each of the said vehicles in column (3) of the said Schedules A, B, C, D and E for a period of 25 years, commencing from the 1st April 2005 and ending on the 30th April 2030 at the following toll collection centres, namely :—

- (1) Khalapur main toll plaza ;
- (2) Talegaon main toll plaza ;
- (3) Khalapur connector ramp plaza ;
- (4) Kusgaon connector ramp plaza ;
- (5) Shedung toll plaza for Panvel bypass.

Notes.—

1. Non-propelled vehicles, two wheelers, three wheelers, tractors are not permitted on Expressway.

2. The vehicles crossing more than one toll collection centres shall be required to pay toll charges only once at the first toll collection centre.

3. The following types of vehicles are exempted from payment of toll :—

(i) Defence Vehicles ;

(ii) Vehicles with Red and Amber lights ;

(iii) Vehicls of the following dignitaries and their entourage :—

President and Vice President of India, Governors, Central and State Minister, Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha, Rajya Sabha and State Legislatures having status of Cabinet Minister, Speakers, Chairmen of Central and State Legislature, Foreign Dignitaries on State visit to India.

(iv) Members of Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of Maharashtra State and Members of Parliament ;

(v) Police Vehicles ;

(vi) Fire Fighting Vehicles ;

(vii) Ambulance and Accident Relief Vehicles ;

(viii) Hearses ;

(ix) Government vehicles of officers inspecting and monitoring the project.

4. For this purpose, the Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation Ltd., Mumbai or its authorised agent is authorised to collect and retain the amount of toll at the abovementioned five toll collection centres.
